
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SCSEP CONNECT

SCSEP is not considered employment, but a temporary job training program to help participants gain the skills and experience needed to secure employment.

BRING YOUR RED, WHITE, AND BLUE MEDICARE CARD TO YOUR APPOINTMENT, EVEN IF YOU HAVE A MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN. OTHERWISE, YOU MAY BE ASKED FOR YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER TO VERIFY YOU'RE ON MEDICARE.



I'M ALREADY VACCINATED. DO I NEED A BOOSTER?

IF YOU ARE AGE 65 AND OLDER OR HAVE CERTAIN HEALTH RISKS, A BOOSTER MAY BE RECOMMENDED. SPEAK WITH YOUR DOCTOR TO LEARN MORE.

Undecided? Older adults are highly at risk from COVID-19. Over 80% of Americans 65 and older are vaccinated, but it could be lower where you live. Learn more about the vaccine at www.cdc.gov/coronavirus.
